The Cardiovascular Technology degree program at Central Georgia Technical College received initial CAAHEP accreditation on March 31, 2015.

The program will publish a 3 year review window average results of the outcomes for national credentialing exam pass rate, retention, and positive placement of the accredited program.

#### **2016 Results:**

**Retention:** 10 students were selected based on competitive admissions in the Invasive Cardiovascular Technology program. As of Fall Semester 2016 (201714) 50% (5 of 10) students were retained.

**Credentialing exam pass rate:** 100% (3 out of 3) students of the 2015 enrollment class, attempted Cardiac Credentialing International's Registered Invasive Cardiovascular Specialist examination 33% (1 out of 3) passed.

**Positive Placement:** 100% (3 out of 3) students of the 2015 enrollment class, successfully attained employment.

#### **2015 Results:**

**Retention:** 16 students were selected based on competitive admissions; 6 students chose the Invasive program. As of Fall Semester, 2015 (201614), 50% (3 of 6) students were retained.
