



Paramedic Program

The Paramedic program at Central Georgia Technical College received initial CAAHEP accreditation on 23 March 2015.

In accordance with CAAHEP Standard V.A.4., The program will publish, preferably in a readily accessible place on their websites, the 3-year review-window average results of the outcomes for: National Registry (or State, as applicable) Written and Practical Exams, Retention, and Positive Placement.

All paramedic classes graduate in December.

Pre-Accreditation 3 year review window average results for 2014, 2013, and 2012:

National Registry examination: 3 year average – 91% (38 out of 42)

2014: 12 out of 14 graduates passed the National Registry computer adaptive and psychomotor examinations (86%)

2013: All graduates passed the National Registry computer adaptive and psychomotor examinations. (100%)

2012: 22 out of 24 graduates passed the National Registry computer adaptive and psychomotor examinations. (92%)

Retention: 3 year average – 64% (42 out of 66)

2014: 19 students registered. 14 graduated from the program for a retention rate of 74%

2013: 13 students registered. 4 students successfully completed for a retention rate of 31%.

2012: 34 students registered. 24 Students successfully completed the program for a retention rate of 71%.

Positive Placement: 3 year average – 100% (38 out of 38)

2014: All students were employed in field. (14 out of 14)

2013: All students were employed in field. (4 out of 4)

2012: All students were employed in field. (22 out of 22)
