A grade will be assigned for a dropped course (W,WP,WF). Dropping a class affects your pass rate at the college. | Always see your advisor before dropping or adding courses to your schedule. | Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) | SAP is based on your academic standing and affects your ability to register for classes and your eligibility to receive MOWR funds. | Academic standing is based on your cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) and your Course Completion Rate. See New Student Orientation or Catalog for more information. | In order to continue to participate in the Move on When Ready program and receive aid, students must maintain a 2.0 GPA and complete 67% of all attempted hours. |
